



Campolindo Women's Choir Attire: Dress and Shoes

All choir women are required to wear a Campolindo choir dress for school performances. Fittings for all new choir women will take place in the classroom in early September. Since dresses are fitted for dress bodice, sleeve, and hem lengths, the expectation is that alterations will not be needed, or will be minimal. Choir dress order forms are available in the class and on campchoir.com. Dresses should be delivered to students in mid November.

Important: If you already own a Campolindo choir dress and do not need to order a new one, simply check the appropriate box on the order form and return it.

The cost of a new choir dress is \$75. Parents may make payment through the Campolindo webstore (Cougar Day), or students may deliver a check payable to CCMEF (Campolindo Choral Music Education Fund), to Mr. Roberts. Payment is due by **Tuesday, Sept. 8, 2014**. Please put your student's name in the memo line if paying by check. These custom-fitted dresses cannot be refunded.

ALSO...All choir women are required to wear a pair of black, Mary-Jane style character shoes (not T-strap), with a 1 ½ inch heel.
