

Director's Notes

magine 1957, the year West Side Story opened: A prevailing fear of communism led to hyper-patriotism and paranoia. A youth culture had begun to emerge, embracing rock and roll, rebellious fashion and independence. The Civil Rights movement roiled as school desegregation efforts faltered and festered. This was a time marked by a prevailing sense of social conformity and conservatism, emphasizing traditional gender roles, nuclear family structures, and a conformist social order. West Side Story dropped onto Broadway in the midst of this and it was like nothing seen or heard there before. One critic described the influence and aftermath of its opening as "nuclear fallout on Broadway."

It has been an interesting journey, directing West Side Story for the second time on our stage. Much has changed since 2016... but a lot has not. There is a greater sensitivity around "othering" people by categorizing them as this type, that ethnicity, or a particular personality. We are all called to be more intentional, thoughtful, contemplative, and cognizant of the impact our words and actions have on others. The authors of West Side Story saw it as a plea for peace and yet, we have only to look at the news feed on our phones to see moment-by-moment examples of the "warfare" described in our story.

Rather than shy away from controversial subject matter, we've elected to dive into this story and challenge our students and audiences to examine, yet again, themes that have been presented on stages across the world since Shakespeare's day and before. "Stick to your own kind!" "Move where you're wanted!" "Every one of you hates every one of us, and we hate you right back!" "Pitiful what you Puerto Ricans have done to this neighborhood!" These lines from the show and their derivatives are still, after 67 years, relevant to daily life in 2024. We have asked our actors to portray some dangerous, disgusting, hateful behavior. We hope that, by understanding and presenting this iconic, classic tale, they can poke at the complacency that some seem able to retreat to here in our place of "peace and quiet and open air," where we have "time together with time to spare, time to learn, time to care." I find it interesting how our story portrays the devolution that occurs right after those lyrics are sung.

The senseless warfare between rivals over the differences in their culture, their religion, the way they speak and the color of their skin is not something to walk away from. The tragic outcomes in our story highlight the senselessness of it all, though we are left to wonder about what happens to the survivors, as they gravitate, time and again, even in the very last moments of the show, to their own "corners."

We welcome Michelle Anjani as chief choreographer for this dance-heavy show. A Campolindo alumna, she played Anita in our 2016 production. Her perspective as a woman of color and her attention to detail, willingness to push our non-dancers beyond their comfort level and her creativity as an artist have been invaluable. She has accurately captured the original Jerome Robbins look and feel, while adapting each number to fit a large cast that is largely untrained.

Leonard Bernstein's score, widely thought of as the best in musical theater, is a "bear" to play. The demands of the orchestral music are, more than anything, what had kept this play from CPAC for many years. The Campolindo instrumental music program has a deep enough pool of talent to rise to this challenge, under the waving (but unwavering) baton of our Music Director and Producer, Mark Roberts.


Our story of young love is as timely as ever... the undercurrent of racial distrust and hatred that ultimately overcomes these star-crossed lovers plays out across the globe just as it did in Shakespeare's 16th century Verona; in Gaza, Israel, Ferguson, Atlanta, Yemen, Ukraine, New York. The epithet, "Immigrant!" hurled by white teens at their Puerto Rican neighbors could not be more topical.

"Why do you live like there's a war on?" asks Doc in Act 2, "Why do you kill?"

Why indeed?

At the end of Romeo and Juliet, the Prince says: "See, what a scourge is laid upon your hate, That heaven finds means to kill your joys with love."

Perhaps we may yet find a new way of living... someday, somehow, somewhere.


Ara Purdy
